



SEASON'S GREETINGS FROM YOUR POSTAL CARRIER!

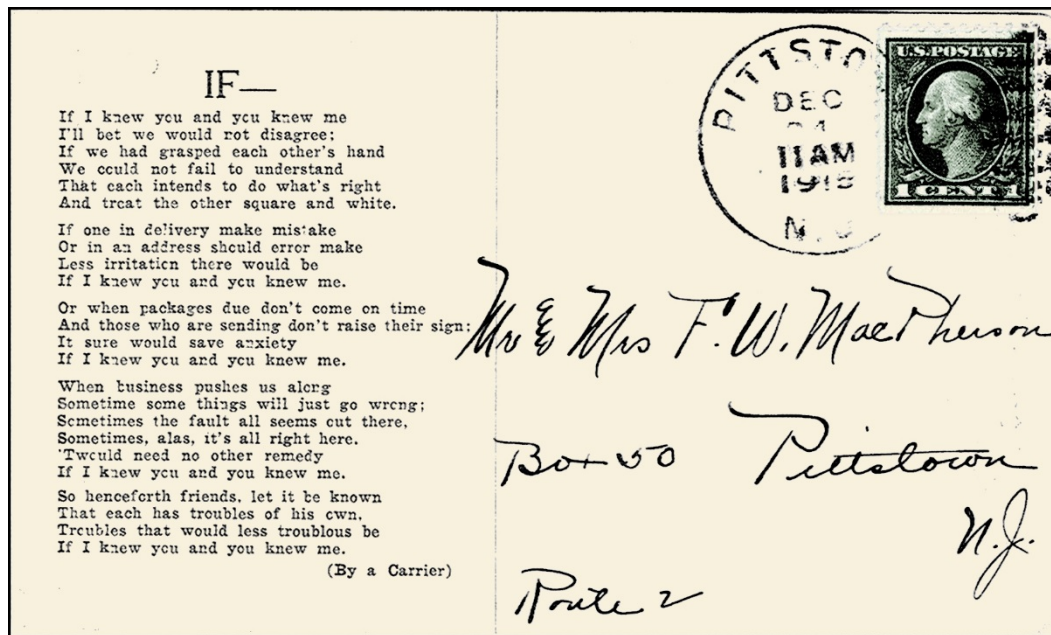
